

2018 GENERAL TRACK RULES

- **Race Receivers Are Mandatory In All Divisions**
- **Transponders Are Mandatory for all divisions (except Challengers), anyone found not using the device as required will NOT BE SCORED for that race.**
- All Cars Competing Must Furnish Stateline Motorsports Park With a **W-9 FORM** and a **DRIVER REGISTRATION FORM** Prior to any Car Competing. Both Forms are available on newstatelinespeedway.com or at the track in the Pit Shack.
- **All Cars Must Have Numbers** that are “**Clearly Visible**” on the roof and both sides of the car in contrasting color to the car, we will no longer allow duct tape numbers or spray can numbers, as many times they cannot be clearly seen from the tower.
Any car deemed unreadable, from the tower, will not be scored.
- All drivers are responsible for registering their car each night, **PILL DRAW CUT OFF IS 6:30.** The Car must be in the pits to draw. Anyone not checked in at least 30 minutes before race time will push the field. **See notation
**However, If there is a circumstance beyond your control, we are allowing you to call someone at the track to draw a position in your absence, However, this is limited to 2 times for the 2018 season. If you have someone draw a number for you and you don't make it to the track, this is still considered one of your allotted byes.

PILOT PROGRAM

PIT ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR UNDER 14

- Prior to entering the pit area, ALL children regardless of age must have a MINOR RELEASE form signed by a parent and/or a Minor Entry Card issued by the track. The MINOR RELEASE form can be found on newstatelinespeedway.com under Rules/Forms. This form must be filled out and presented prior to minors entry into the pit area. The Release Form will be kept on file and a Minor Entry Card will be issued by the track.
- The Minor Entry Card must be presented each week prior to entry into the pit area.
- Every Minor entering the pit area **MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A Responsible Adult!**
- Stateline Speedway reserves the right to implement penalties for unsupervised children at their discretion. 1st Offense = 1-month Suspension; 2nd Offense = Expulsion.
- This is a TEST Program so please be aware of your surroundings and watch for violations, so that a few don't ruin it for all.
- **Anyone entering the pits is responsible for reading and understanding the "Release and Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement" The pit area is not to be entered at any time unless officials are on the premises.**
- Anyone caught in the pit area without a wrist-band will be immediately suspended along with all members of the team they are associated with, this includes the car and driver. No Refunds!

SAFETY RULES

Stateline Speedway Recommends the use of an Approved Fire Suppression System for all cars competing. **AN APPROVED FIRE SUPPRESSION SYSTEM IS MANDATORY FOR THE SUPER LATE MODELS.** System must be Securely Mounted & Accessible from both Inside and Outside of Car. It is also suggested to have a fire extinguisher in the hauler.

- ASA or SNELL HELMETS MANDATORY, Not Older Than 5 Years from Date of Manufacture.
- FIRE SUIT MANDATORY-Fireproof clothing must not be torn
- All driver SEAT BELT systems shall not be in excess of 3 years of age past the date of manufacture.
- HEAD and NECK RESTRAINTS – Mandatory for SUPER LATE, CRATE LATE, OUTLAW E-MOD & ANYONE 16 & UNDER.
- A Padded Neck Brace IS MANDATORY minimum protection for all divisions.
- Stateline Speedway HIGHLY recommends the use of a head and neck restraint.
- Any Extra Weight Must Have 2-½” GRADE 5 or Better Bolts Holding Weight on - NO EXCEPTIONS!
- NO WEIGHT Can Be Mounted or Bolted to Any Suspension Parts – If Weights are found Mounted that way, they will be removed before the Car goes onto the track.
- All Weights MUST be Painted White with Driver Number on them, NO EXCEPTIONS!
- You MUST have a TOW HOOK or Chain on the Front and Rear of car.

Wheelers MUST Have Insurance and Be Registered at the Track!

- To register you must provide a copy of Current Insurance Card, Make, Model and Color of Wheeler. You will be issued a sticker that permits use of that vehicle in the pit area at the track. Registration cost is \$50 per year.
- Wheeler must be registered before operating at the track. Penalty's for operating wheeler prior to registration will be... **1st offense:** Parked for the Night; **2nd Offense:** PARKED REST OF THE YEAR
- Anyone operating a motorized vehicle must have a Drivers License.
- Seat must be utilized for all riders, with a maximum of 2 people. No riding on front or rear carriers.
- Race Cars Have Right Away! All Wheelers MUST yield to race cars! Failure to do so will result in being parked.
- WHEELERS MUST BE PARKED, OR IN TRAILER AS SOON AS RACES ARE OVER.
- For individuals with handicap card in their name, there will be no charge.

Side-By-Sides MUST Have Insurance and Be Registered at the Track!

To register you must provide a copy of Current Insurance Card, Make, Model and Color of Side-by-Side. You will be issued a sticker that permits use of that vehicle in the pit area at the track. Registration cost is \$75 per year.

Side-by-Side must be registered before operating at the track. Penalty's for operating prior to registration will be... **1st offense:** Parked for the Night; **2nd Offense:** PARKED REST OF THE YEAR

Anyone operating a motorized vehicle must have a drivers license.

A maximum of Only 2 people on the Side-By-Side.

Race Cars Have Right Away! All Side-By-Sides MUST yield to race cars! Failure to do so will result in being parked.

ALL MONIES RECEIVED FOR REGISTRATION OF WHEELERS AND SIDE-BY-SIDES WILL GO TOWARDS THE POINT FUND.

- Stateline Speedway reserves the right to revoke operation at their discretion.

FINES AND/OR SUSPENSIONS WILL BE IMPOSED FOR THE FOLLOWING:

- **Drivers doing spin-outs or speeding in the pits will not go back out on the track.**
- Crew members are not permitted on the track during race conditions including cautions.
- Driving on the race track, the pit area, or parking lot during off hours is prohibited. Severe fines, suspensions, and arrests will be imposed. If you need to come and look for something – just call first. Access will be given.
- Anyone who drives a car without registering both car and driver
- ANY Racecar left on the track
- If anyone associated with your team goes to another car or pit without an official - money forfeited.
- Any abusive physical or verbal altercations with officials or employees
- If any car goes on to the race track after the races are over
- Anyone not making requested changes to car by specified time
- Anyone caught allowing illegal access
- Anyone failing to leave the track when ordered to do so. Anyone going to the flag stand to confront an official. Anyone leaving tires at the track will forfeit their money won for that night.

Reserved parking spots for the year are available. Prior Year Occupation has priority in reserving the same spot. Once paid a PARKING sticker will be provided and your spot is Reserved

The track is not responsible for ANY racecar left AT the track, whether in the pits or parking lot
