Overnight Parking at Stateline Speedway

- 1) There will be no more than 20 vehicles parked on the grounds overnight. If the operator anticipates a larger than average event and wishes to allow additional vehicles to park overnight the operator must contact CCHD at least two (2) weeks prior to the event.
- 2) Overnight parking will be limited to Saturday through Sunday at noon (12:00 pm).
- 3) All vehicles that stay overnight must be self-contained. A self-contained vehicle is defined as having, at a minimum, a toilet, a holding tank for sewage and greywater wastewater and a holding tank for clean drinking water or the vehicle owner must be staying with someone onsite who has these amenities.
- 4) There will be no water available from the facility to feed vehicles (i.e. no hoses run from the facility's water supply).
- 5) There will be no electric available from the facility to feed vehicles (i.e. no power cords from the existing facility supply to vehicles or no power cords run between vehicles to share generator power).
- 6) Overnight guests will not rely on Stateline Speedway restrooms and must have access to restroom facilities in their self-contained vehicle.
- 7) All vehicles must be parked with at least ten (10) foot of space between all outside surfaces; this includes slideouts and recreational vehicle extensions such as canopys.
- 8) There will be no campfires or burn barrels on Stateline Speedway grounds.
- There will be no dumping of grey water or black water at the Stateline Speedway facility.
- 10) There must be a responsible person onsite who will ensure that these requirements are being met from the time vehicles begin arriving at the facility until the point when they have all left the facility (i.e Saturdays through Sundays at 12:00pm).
